Półwysep Howth (irl. *Ceann Bhinn Éadair*) to malownicze, skaliste wzniesienie w hrabstwie Fingal, stanowiące północną granicę Zatoki Dublińskiej i urokliwą dzielnicę Dublina. Słynie z dramatycznych klifów, szlaków spacerowych (np. [Cliff Path Loop](#)), latarni morskiej oraz aktywnego portu rybackiego, oferując ucieczkę od miejskiego zgiełku zaledwie 15-20 km od stolicy

Kilkenny uznawane jest za jedno z lepiej zachowanych, średniowiecznych miast w Irlandii. Położone nad malowniczą rzeką Nore może się poszczycić całkiem pokaźną listą atrakcji i zabytków. Pobyt w mieście rozpocznij w **St. Mary's Medieval Mile Museum**. To tam będziesz mógł zapoznać się z fascynującą historią Kilkenny, a to wszystko we wnętrzach dawnego XIII-wiecznego kościoła Mariackiego. Oczywiście odwiedź też **Kilkenny Castle**, który otoczony jest pięknym i rozległym parkiem ciągnącym się wzdłuż rzeki.



Glendalough ([irl. Gleann Dá Loch](#), dosł. „dolina dwóch jezior”) – [dolina](#) położona w [górach Wicklow](#) w [Irlandii](#). Także historyczna osada i [średniowieczny klasztor](#) o tej samej nazwie.
