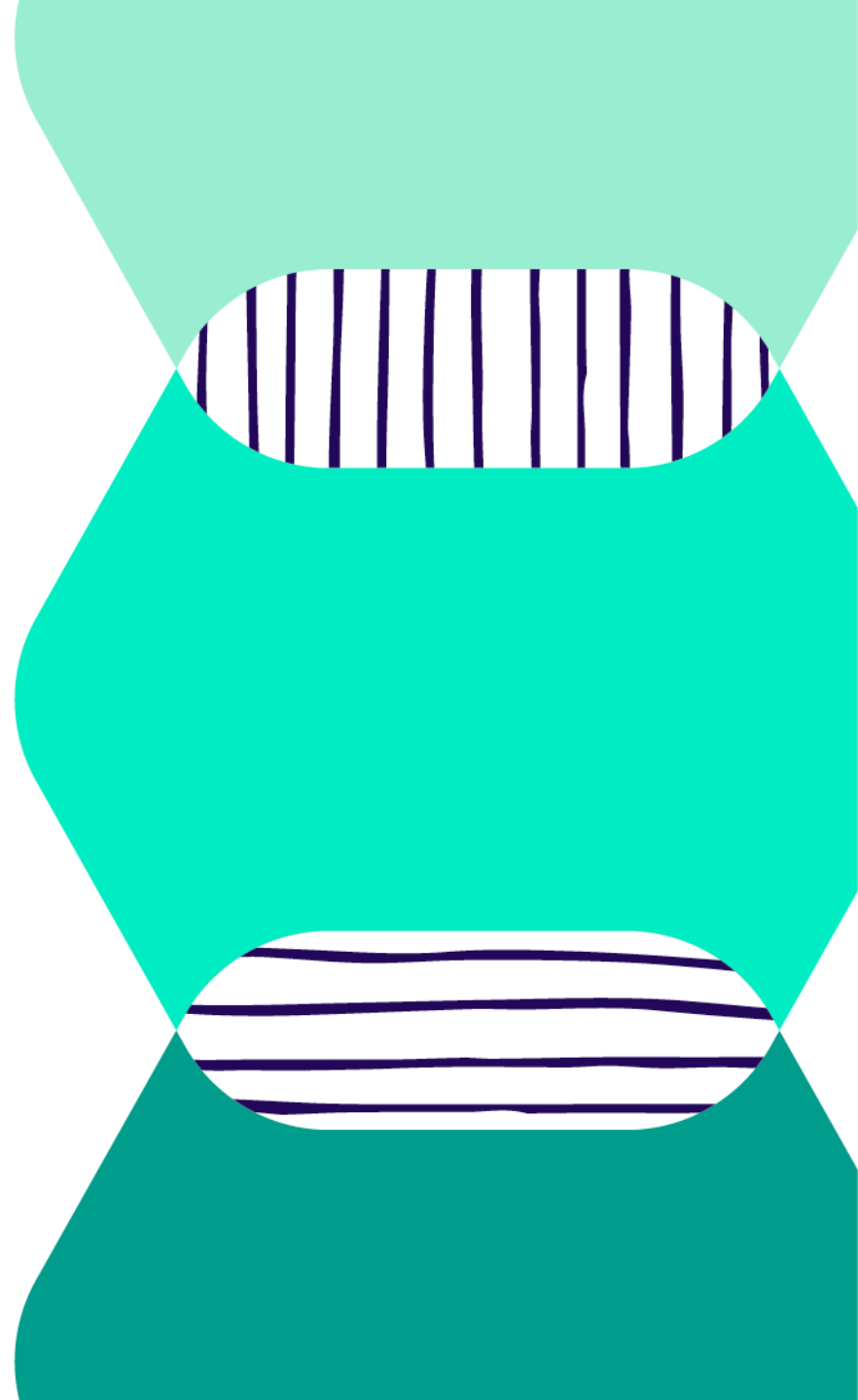

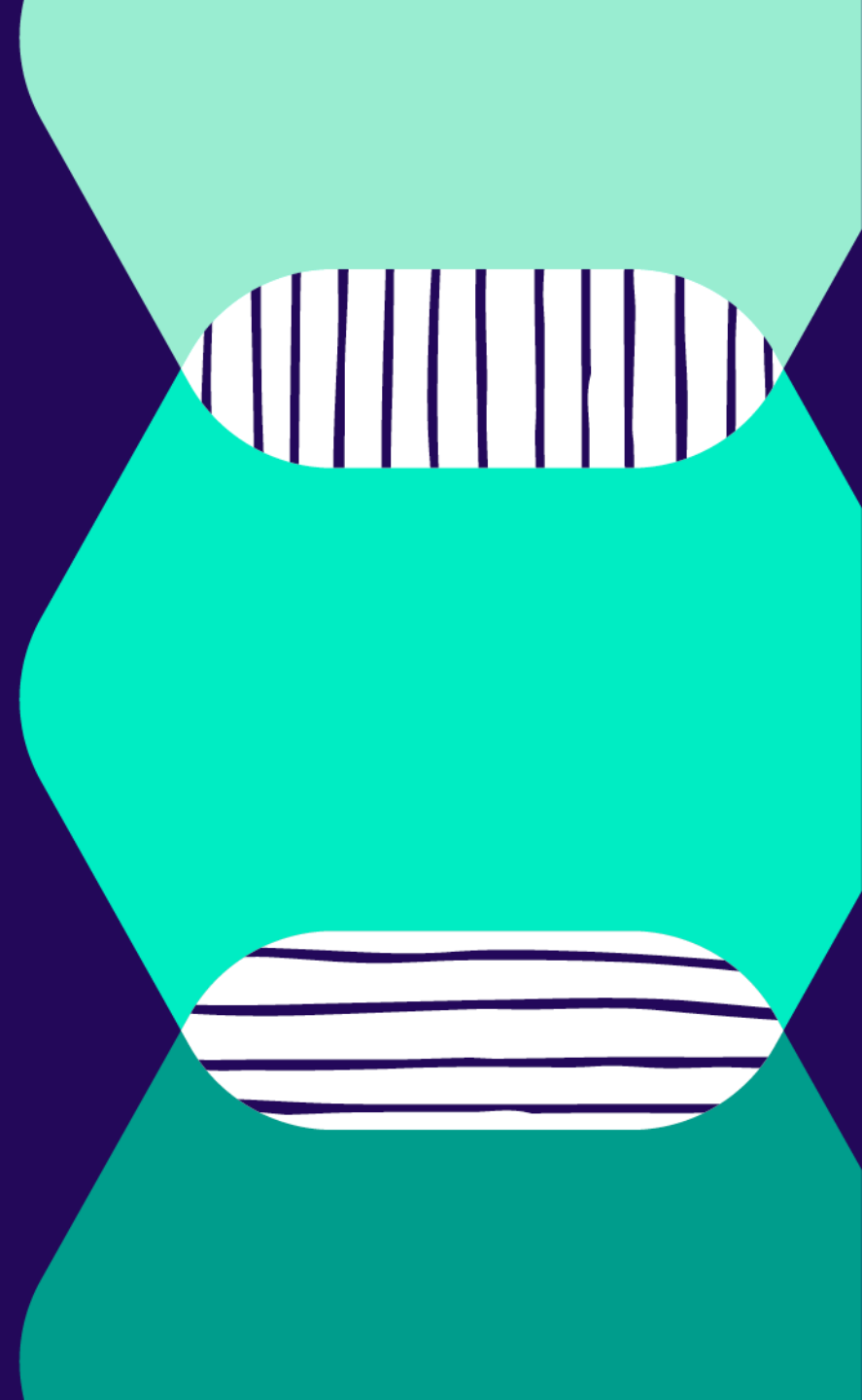

with student achievement**

Lesson 3: What does good bilingual (CLIL) teaching look like?

- **Child centred** - needs of the learners are at the heart of planning and our teaching
- **Inclusive** – high ceiling, low threshold
- **Scaffolding strategies** - we need our own toolkits
- **Authentic texts, visuals, models, routines**
- **An integrated approach** (English + subjects)
- **Assessment for Learning**

Lesson 4: Does bilingual Education (CLIL) benefit pupils?

2010

- Performance & attainments: “ ... we discern a strongly positive picture and conclude that the majority of students are gaining much from their bilingual education. They are reaching commendable levels of attainment, in their everyday classroom performance, their spoken English, their written English, their written Spanish and also in the IGCSE examination.”

2017

- English Impact: positive impact on attainment: reduction of gap between high / low SES pupils
- Significant impact on motivation towards language learning
